







What is this training about?

I-MLL is an evidence-based professional development system that early childhood professionals can use to support the development of children who are learning English while also continuing to develop their home and other languages. I-MLL takes an integrative approach including strategies for creating culturally and linguistically responsive learning environments, social-emotional, language, and cognitive strategies to effectively support infants, toddlers, and preschoolers who are multi-language learners (MLLs) in collaboration with their families.

The I-MLL training sessions provided will focus on how faculty can support their students learn about these strategies.

In addition to the faculty-focused sessions, some specialized sessions will be provided for lab students and early childhood teachers.

Learning objectives of this training include the following:

- Understand the foundations for Multi-Language Learners (MLLs) development and the Integrated Multi-Language Learners System (I-MLL)
- Learn strategies to create culturally responsive and engaging learning environments for MLLs (Body I-MLL)
- Learn strategies to support the socialemotional development of MLLs (Heart I-MLL)
- Learn strategies to support the language and cognitive development of MLLs (Mind I-MLL)
